Merime started his musical career in 2010 in Australia as a busker before becoming the leader of the former Melbournian band Chalouche, mixing gypsy music and French song writing.

As a solo performer and bandleader, he played in numerous concert venues of the Melbournian scene, and in various Australian festivals for a growing audience of enthusiastic followers, all drawn in by the generosity, presence and uplifting atmosphere of his shows. In 2013, he recorded with Chalouche his first Ep, Mon Errance.

In January 2016, Merime moved back to France and for 2 years worked on the release of his first solo album, "L'Eveil – The Awakening."
